**INTR-3003. Experiential Community-Based Internship**

This course provides students with a hands-on learning experience through a community-based internship. Students will work with a community organization or agency to address a real-world problem. The course is designed to develop students' critical thinking, problem-solving, and communication skills. Students will be required to complete a reflective journal and a final report on their internship experience.

**INTR-4003. Interdisciplinary Honours Workshop**

This workshop is designed for students who are interested in pursuing an interdisciplinary honours program. The workshop will provide students with an opportunity to explore the intersection of different disciplines and to develop a research proposal for their honours thesis. The workshop will include guest speakers, panel discussions, and hands-on activities.

**INTR-4016. Interdisciplinary Honours Thesis**

This course is the final stage of the interdisciplinary honours program. Students will be required to complete a research proposal, conduct research, and write a thesis. The thesis will be evaluated by a panel of faculty members. The course is designed to provide students with a rigorous and challenging academic experience.
