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exemption for substantial medical or compassionate reasons will be required to provide supporting documentation, if applicable. For more detailed information about the appeal procedure, students may contact the Registrar's O ce.

Appeal of Final Grade in Course

A student may apply for a review of the nal grade in any course, as follows:

- 1. The student shall apply in writing to the Registrar's O ce no later than two months after receipt of the nal grade;
- 2. The Registrar's O ce shall ask the professor to review the nal grade. The review shall involve the nal examination, if any, and the student's class record, wherever possible;
- 3. If the student chooses to appeal the professor's review of the nal grade, the Registrar's O ce shall submit the matter to the Chair of the Department. This review will involve consultation with the professor, if available, and may involve consultation with other professor(s) appointed by the Chair (Note: when the appeal concerns the Chair, the Dean shall act as Chair):
- 4. If the student chooses to appeal the Chair's review, the matter shall be referred to the Senate Student Academic Grievance Committee which will review all its aspects; the
